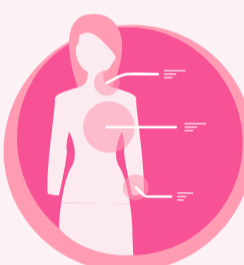

- Screened / symptomatic
- Mammography & other imaging

HISTOLOGY



- DCIS/LCIS
- Morphology / variants
- ER / PR / HER2 status
- Tumour size and grade
- TNM stage / NPI
- Proliferation measures*

THERAPIES



- Neoadjuvant & adjuvant
- Chemotherapy
- Endocrine therapy
- Biological therapies
- Radiation
- Clinical trials
- Treatment withheld/declined

ADVANCED BREAST CANCER



- Time to relapse
- Loco-regional recurrence
- Metastasis
- Sites of recurrence
- Surgery / Therapies
